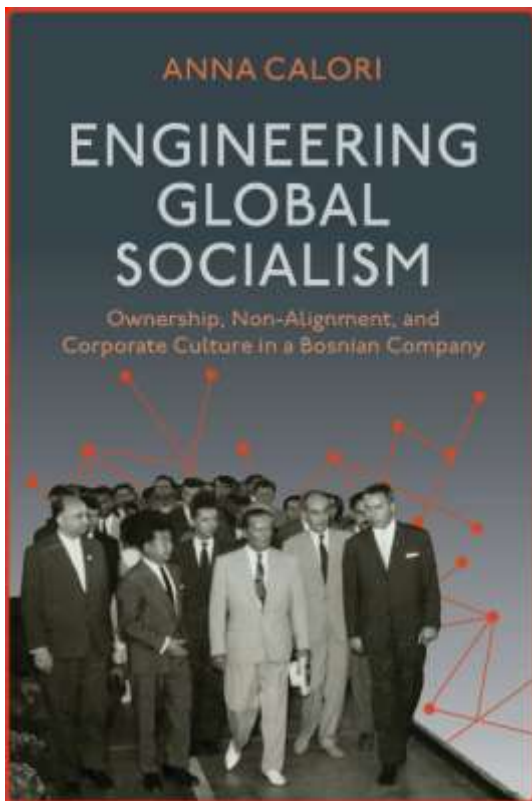


“Ownership, Non-Alignment, and Corporate Culture in a Bosnian Company”

The book talk chronicles the journey of the Bosnian global corporation *Energoinvest* and its workers from its Yugoslav socialist ideals through decades of dissolution, reconstruction, and post-socialist transformation. Tracing the long trajectory of a Yugoslav enterprise through decades of large-scale social change, this book presents a historical and sociological moment in which workers' ideas about social and corporate enterprise offered the possibility of a more democratic path to globalization.

Anna Calori is a Lecturer in Contemporary Economic History at the University of Glasgow. Her interests are in the global economic and social history of the Cold War and its aftermath.
